BUS DROP AND COLLECTION POINT

Buses to follow route per enclosed map, entering via Alderbury Street, between Matthews Netball Centre and Wembley Oval into the carpark. Buses are to PROMPTLY move out of this area once students have been dropped off, onto Selby Street, which is a ONE WAY exit in a southerly direction.

ARRIVAL

- 'Check in' on arrival
- **Wristband** collection for those who **do not** have photo permissions
- Peer support students are requested to collect a **yellow hi visual vest** from the ACC

MARQUEES

Schools are advised to bring a small marquee and ground mat, and set up per enclosed map. The western end of the pavilion verandah **can not** be utilised due to SEDA College WA class on site.

EQUIPMENT

- Football boots and shin pads are **not** to be worn
- Mouthguards are optional, but not a necessity
- Schools are to bring playing bibs, which are to be worn should sport uniforms clash
- All balls, cones and goals will be provided and set up by sporting partners



TOILET FACILITIES AND RAMP ACCESS

- Ramp access per enclosed map
- Public toilet facilities on Wembley Oval side of facilities : access via central stairs (divides clubhouse and changerooms) or via ramp (western side of clubhouse)
x1 male ambulant toilet x1 female ambulant toilet
- Accessible changeroom available for those that require such, located at eastern end of verandah.
x1 unisex ambulant toilet x1 UAT

VENUE FACILITIES

- Coffee van will be on site for the duration of the venue
- Water fountains marked on enclosed map
- Cricket centre wicket is strictly **out of bounds** and will be cornered off with wicketed cones.

FIRST AID

Students taken to the First Aid Post, must be supervised by a teacher / parent support.

WEATHER

A reminder to ensure students and staff have suitable, warm clothing for the day. Should the weather be deemed not safe for the event to go ahead, the ACC will advise schools by 8am the morning of the event, if not prior. If there is forecast of showers and wind, the event will go ahead.

EVENT FORMAT

- Soccer activity session will be delivered by sporting partners pre-fixture commencement
- Teams to assemble behind allocated number sign, where they will be collected by sporting partners
- Mercy College students will umpire / mentor all games
- Schools are to support scoring games with provided scoresheets. Game results are to be signed by both teams after each game, and provided to the umpires to return to the Carnival Manager
- Clipboards **must** remain on the allocated field
- There are two pools, competitive (Manchester United) and participation (Chelsea)
- Fixtures will be displayed on the reverse of each field sign

- These will be presented to each school during presentations – please ensure you have a student in mind and ready to collect on behalf of your school.

RULES

- Pitch size : approx. **40m (L) x 30m (W)** (marked with cones).
- Games will run for 15 minutes, with **no** half time break
- There is a 10 minute change over time allocated between fixtured round games
- **On field** : 7 players/team, **maximum** of 2 peer students, unlimited substitutions
- Goals are smaller than a standard soccer goal and there are **no goalkeepers**
- A goal area will be marked (with field cones) which **no** player may enter
- General outdoor soccer rules apply, with the following modifications :
 - Side tackles are **not** allowed
 - No offsides
 - The ball may be 'rolled', 'kicked' or 'thrown overhead' from sideline as a restart
- Goals only to be scored from offensive half of field. Goals scored from defensive half of the field, will be disallowed, and a free kick awarded on halfway line
- Defenders to be a minimum of **2m** from the ball, for free kicks, goal kicks and restarts.
- All players are required to play both defence and attack throughout all games
- A ball that contacts a wheelchair is considered to be in a player's possession. The ball is placed in the player's lap and must be pushed back into play
- The maximum distance **any player** can travel with the ball is **10m**

GAMES POINT SCORING

WIN : 3 points

DRAW : 2 points

LOSS : 1 point

FINALS

- Overall game points determine the ladder and finals fixtures. Should not all teams within a pool have a BYE, ladder is determined through goal differential.
- If a **Grand Final** result is a draw, the team with the highest goal differential after fixtured rounds, will determine the overall winner

PEER SUPPORT STUDENTS

- Peer support students are to **play alongside** students, supporting their skills and the game, to facilitate maximum participation from all. They provide mentoring and are **not** lead the direction of play.
- Peer support students are **not** to score, and if they do, the result will not be recorded, with the opposition receiving a free kick out of goals.
